Hiring or contracting producers, exporters, suppliers or service providers is a simple process, though it is advisable to check some aspects beforehand:

- Verification of license and status: service providers are regulated by state of residence;
- Verification of insurance on services and products provided;
- Verification, though the state, of an existing administrative or civil lawsuit;
- Search for references for service provider.
